You may have read about PSC member, Ted Ward, in the recent addition of Point Loma Lifestyles Magazine...but more about that later! Ted heard about PSC when he was looking for a social outlet after losing his wife in 2018 and staying at home throughout the pandemic. A member now for two years, Ted is a frequent rider on PSC vans and is a regular at our monthly luncheons and on PSC Excursions. Born in Chicago, he joined the Navy at age 17 with his teenage best friend when WWII was coming to an end. He married in



Chicago, honeymooned in San Diego and then had three daughters with his wife. After the Navy, Ted earned his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering at Chicago Technology College. He went on to complete his graduate studies in electrical engineering at Illinois Institute of Technology and was hired in Chicago to come to Convair in San Diego where he specialized in aircraft missile electronics. He was also a Hard Hat Diver for the Navy in submarine rescue missions. Ted retired after 25 years as Engineering Manager at Cubic Corporation. A long-time sailing enthusiast, Ted raced small sailboats nearly every weekend at the San Diego Yacht Club winning multiple trophies until eight years ago. Ted was active in surfing, swimming and boogie boarding as well. Ted participated in the 2022 Honor Flight to Washington, DC touring museums honoring our veterans for three days. This spring, Ted was also part of bi-plane exhibition flights at Gillespie Field and was featured in an article about him and seven fellow veterans in the most recent addition of Point Loma Living Magazine. When asked what he enjoys most about PSC, Ted looks forward to socializing at our various activities and being part of our friendly membership. 
Are You Prepared for Storms?

The San Diego County of Emergency Services has tips on how to prepare for storms and other emergencies. You should create a plan, build an emergency kit and sign up for alerts. Check out these helpful tips.

- Create a family disaster plan at <u>alertsandiego.org</u>. Practice evacuating to be prepared at a moment's notice.
- Have an emergency kit ready with necessary items if you had to evacuate, including food and medication.
- Have contingency plans for different times of the day, i.e. while some family members are at work or school.
- In case you are separated during a disaster, discuss where to reunite because phone service may not be reliable during a disaster.
- Your pets are part of your family too. Make sure they are microchipped and that you have a pet disaster plan in place. Learn which items to have packed at sddac.com.
- Register your (and other family members) cellphones with Alert San Diego at **alertsandiego.org** to be notified if an emergency is affecting your neighborhood.
- Get free sandbags at locations throughout the County. Find one near you at alertsandiego.org. Sandbags help divert or redirect water, mud and debris from your property and help prevent soil erosion.
